WHY ARE SANDSTORMS DANGEROUS?

The topsoil helps to hold down trees and when the topsoil is gone, it can cause there to be massive landslides.

Sandstorms that are huge can cover peoples houses and cause them not to be able to get out of their homes. These storms can also cause people to have respiratory problems from breathing too much sand.

Sandstorms can destroy crops quickly and cause crops to die or to not be able to grow.

MORE FACTS ABOUT SANDSTORMS:

- Sandstorms are also called "haboobs." Hab is a word in Arabic that means "wind."
- Sometimes sandstorms travel from the Sahara Desert all the way across the Atlantic Ocean.
- Most of the sandstorms happen in the summertime.
- Sandstorms are in the top five weather conditions that cause the most harm to people.
- Some people call sandstorms, dust storms.
- The area must be dry in order for a sandstorm to form.
- Sandstorms sometimes happen when there is a thunderstorm because usually these produce high winds.
- In the Middle East, there are many sandstorms that happen.
- When people cut down too many trees, the sand becomes exposed and this can cause there to be more sandstorms than normal.
- When grass is present, most of the time sandstorms are stopped.
- In 1930, there was a Dust Bowl, which was dust storms that swept across the area in Southwest America. When this happened, it caused there to be droughts and people were not able to grow food.
